WELCOME

The Santa Clarita Valley Boys' and Girls' Club welcomes you to its Sixth Annual Benefit Auction. The Auction will be divided into two parts: The Live Auction, verbal bidding on thirty-five auction items and The Silent Auction, written bidding for auction items posted on the walls of the Main Gallery, California Institute of the Arts. We ask you to carefully read the Rules of Auction listed on Page 3 of this Catalogue.

The Santa Clarita Valley Boys' Club is a charter member of the Boys' Club of America. The Club serves the needs of boys and girls, ages 7-18, in the communities of Newhall, Saugus, Valencia, Castaic, and Canyon Country. In excess of 1800 children participated in Boys' and Girls' Club programming during the past year. On any one day you could expect to see over 300 children in our programs. This programming takes place primarily on the following school playgrounds: Castaic, Emblem*, Honby, Leona Cox, Mint Canyon, Wiley Canyon, Newhall, Peachland, Rosedell, Skyblue Mesa*, Valley View*. The Asterisks identify the location of our satellite buildings.

The Boys' and Girls' Club hires experienced youth workers to work with the children five to six days each week. Our Program Directors develop programs in social recreation, arts and crafts, special events, intramural sports, and field trips, and do guidance and referral. The emphasis of our efforts is "To Keep Good Kids Good."

In Fiscal Year 1977 (ending on June 30, 1977), the Boys' and Girls' Club's budget was approximately \$110,000. Two thirds of this budget was spent on salaries for our staff. We feel the most effective way to really reach the boys and girls is with caring professional people. An approximate summary of our budget is:

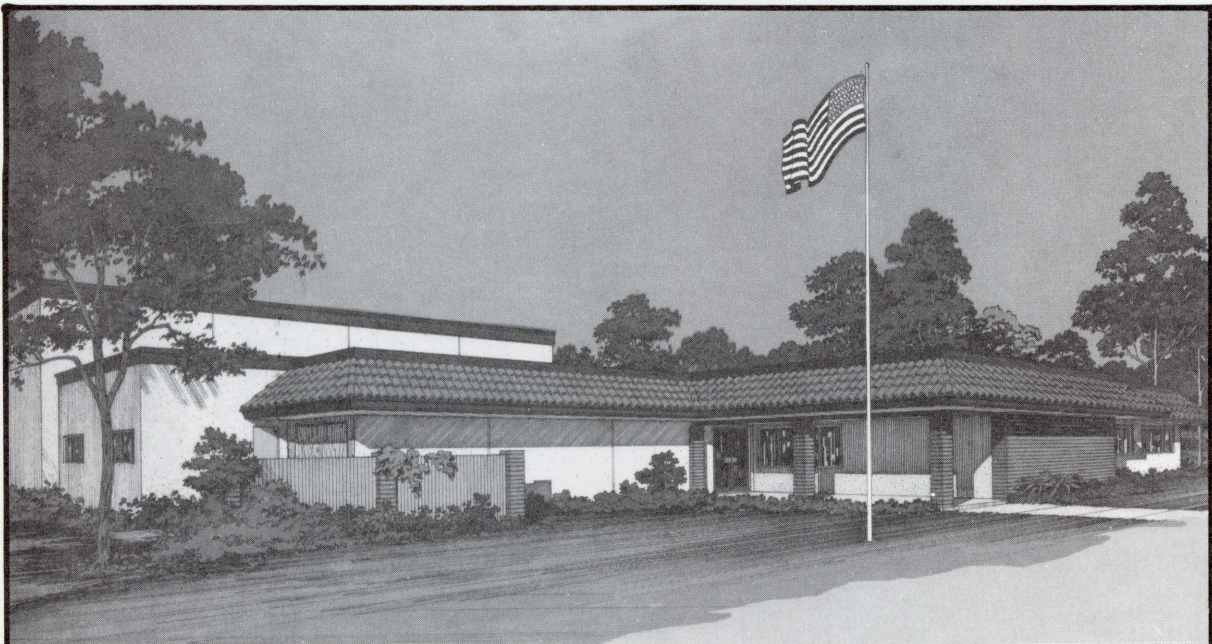

THE RULES OF THE AUCTION

THE LIVE AUCTION

1. The live auction will begin at 9:00 p.m. and will run until approximately 11:00 p.m. It will consist of the voice auctioning of items No. 1-35 in the order that they appear in this catalog and in the addendum.
2. All bidding at the auction will require a bid number. Your personal bid number is your catalog number, located on the back cover of this catalog. On entering the auction, you will be issued a large bid card matching this number. Since this number is required for all bidding and purchasing of items, please remember your number and keep your bid card with you at the auction.
3. During the live auction, when you want to bid on an item, wave your pom-pom or bid card as frantically as possible to attract the auctioneer's attention. If you win an item, immediately announce your bid number to the auctioneer and remain in your seat.
4. A "runner" will bring a sales slip directly to you, indicating the prize you have purchased and the amount of your winning bid. After signing this slip, you are free to proceed to the cash tables to pay for your item and pick up your prize. If you wish, you may wait until the end of the evening and pay for all your purchases at one time at the cash table.

GENERAL RULES

1. The Boys' Club requires that all prizes be paid for in full at the auction. Payment may be made by cash, check, BankAmericard or Master Charge.
2. Unless otherwise specified, all auction items and services must be used within one year from June 11, 1977. All items are transferable from the winner to another person, but may require the approval of the donor.
3. According to the Internal Revenue Service, only the amount paid for an auction prize "in excess of the actual cash value of that prize" is tax deductible. A written receipt indicating such an amount, for tax purposes, will be issued to you after the auction at your request.
4. The Boys' Club guarantees all prizes offered at this auction. Any bidder whose prize is forfeited through no fault of his own, or who is not completely satisfied that his purchase has met the description and conditions specified at the bidding, is entitled to a full refund.
5. All winning bidders are to report to the cashier's table to pay for the items and to claim their prizes. Any bidder not making arrangements for payment at the cashier's table by 12:30 a.m., may, at the discretion of the Boys' Club, forfeit his right to purchase the item and it will be made available to the next highest bidder.

THE SILENT AUCTION RULES

1. The silent auction will begin at 7:00 p.m. and will consist of written bidding on approximately 240 items posted on bid boards along the walls. Eight groups of bid board items are listed in this catalog. Additional items will be added to group 8 and will be listed in the addendum, published just before the auction.

2. Each item can be located according to its group number. Bids will be accepted on each item until the board closes. The following are the closing times:

3. All items in the silent auction have bid sheets attached or affixed nearby. Persons desiring to bid must do so by legibly writing their name, bid card number, and amount of the bid on the bid sheet. Any bid without a bid card number will be automatically disqualified.
4. Each bid sheet notes a minimum value by which the existing bid must be increased in order to constitute a higher valid bid. Each new bid must be written on the uppermost blank line available on the bid sheet.
5. All bids must be in even dollar amounts (no cents). Any bid which includes cents (other than \$.00) will be automatically disqualified.
6. The bid boards will be closed approximately at the times stated here in the catalog. However, the official closing will be that time when the Boys' Club Official actually removes the bid sheet from the board.
7. In the event that bidding is still in progress when the Boys' Club Official attempts to close the board, the Official shall conduct a live auction on the spot allowing all persons present to bid, and shall determine the winning bidder, subject to rule 8 below.
8. After the bid board is closed, the bid sheet will be taken to the item verification table. At this time the validity of all bids will be verified (bid number, even dollar bids, minimum increase, etc.) The highest valid bid will be declared the winner. Decision of the operations official will be final.

Shortly after the board is closed, an official shall post the bid number of the winning bidder on the board.

ADDITIONS AND CORRECTIONS

This catalog contains only those items available at the time of publication. A special addendum, to be published and given to each guest at the auction, will list an additional group of bid board items. The addendum will also list all corrections and deletions necessary for any item published in this catalog.

BANKAMERICARD AND MASTER CHARGE ACCEPTED
Both Master Charge and BankAmericard cards will be accepted at the auction for all expenses and purchases, including admission catalogs, bar and raffle tickets, and for purchasing all auction prizes.
