I doclare that I am unmarried; that my former PIRST: wife, Winifred Westover Hart, and I were diverced February 11, 1927; that she has been amply provided for under a property settlement agreement made in May of 1922; and that she has no rights in, or claims upon, my ostate whatsoover.

SECOMD: I further declare that I have but one child, a son by the name of William S. Hart, Jr., who is the issue of my marriago to said Winifred Westover Hart. I have made no provision in this Will for my son for the reason that I have amply provided for him during my lifetime.

THIRD: I horoby direct my executors, hereinafter named, to pay all my just dobts, all expenses of my last illness and burial, all estate, inheritance, income and other taxes payable from estate funds, and all administration costs, expenses, fees and commissions as soon after my doath as is convenient, out of the residue of my estate, and that there shall be no charge therefor upon the basis of proration, apportionment, contribution, or otherwise, against the devise and bequest herein made to the County of Los Angelos, Stato of California, provided for in paragraphs Fourth and Fifth hereof. In the event such debts, expenses, taxos, costs, fees and commissions exceed the amount of the residue of my estate, I hereby

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direct that, for the purpose of obtaining funds to pay such deficiency, my executors deduct the amount thereof from the bequests set forth in paragraph Sixth hereof upon a pro-rata basis.

FOURTH: I hereby give, devise and bequeath to the County of Los Angeles, State of California, a body politic and corporate, (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "the County"), for the uses and purposes, and upon and subject to the conditions, hereinafter set forth, all that certain real and personal property described as follows, to-wit:

Real Property: My ranch located at Newhall, County of Los Angeles, State of California, consisting of approximately 200 acres of land, including all buildings and other improvements located thereon.

My home and the outbuildings and land reasonably necessary thereto are hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Museum Property".

That the various buildings immediately opposite the main entrance to said proporty which I have used as "location sites" in connection with certain scenes taken in various motion pictures in which I have acted, together with the land reasonably necessary thereto, are hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Location Property".

That the balance of the said 200 acres is hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Park Property".

Porsonal Property: All the furniture and furnishings, and other personal property located in the Museum Property, except such of my clothing, articles of personal attire or adornment, articles of household furniture or equipment which in the opinion of my executors have no historic value, or which are not suitable for the purposes of a park or museum, hereinafter semetimes referred to as "Museum Pieces".

A. That the said roal and personal property (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Park") shall be forever used
and maintained by the County and its successors in interest and
estate, exclusively as a public park and pleasure grounds, and for
exhibition purposes, for the amusement, recreation, health and
pleasure of its inhabitants. That the Park shall be open to public
use at all times subject to proper restrictions to be provided by
the Board of Supervisors of the County. That a charge or fee shall
never be made of the public for admittance to the said premises,

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- B. That the name of said Park shall be established by ordinance to be "WILLIAM S. HART PARK", and that "WILLIAM S. HART PARK" shall be continued as the official name and designation of said Park.
- C. That, within twelve months from and after the date of the recordation of the decree of distribution distributing the said property to the County, the County shall
- (1) Construct and thereafter maintain at the present location of the main entrance to said property a plate on which shall be inscribed in letters of suitable size and character the words "WILLIAM S. HART PARK"; and, that at a proper location on or adjacent to the Museum Property, place or erect a tablet on which shall be inscribed in letters of suitable size and character the following words:

"This Park has been dedicated

by

WILLIAM S. HART

for the benefit of the American Public of every race and croed"

- D. That, within five years from and after the date of the recordation of said decree of distribution, the County shall
- (1) Lay out, construct and thereafter maintain roads and paths throughout the said property so as to give the public access to the various points and places of interest throughout the Park.
- (2) Construct and thereafter maintain comfort stations for the

- (4) Lay out, construct and thereafter maintain an adequate electric lighting system, irrigation system and storm drains throughout the Park.
- (5) Plant and thereafter maintain throughout the Park, at suitable places, for the purpose of ernamentation and flood control, plants, shrubs, trees, grass and flowers preferable indigenous to California.
- E. The Museum Property shall be maintained in its present location and hept in good repair.
- F. A room shall be set apart in either the Museum Property or Location Property for the supervisor of the Park who shall have general supervision over the property.
- G. At all times when the Museum is open to the public a guard shall be maintained within the Museum for the purpose of protecting the Museum Pieces and Property.
- H. All Museum Pioces of intrinsic value, and which may be easily carried away, shall be enclosed and kept under glass.
- I. No business of any kind shall be conducted upon said property, nor shall said property or any portion thereof be used for the purpose of development of oil, gas or other hydrocarbon or other mineral substances. Provided, however, that the use of said property for transportation purposes for carrying persons into and through said property shall not be considered as a violation of any of the conditions herein set forth.
- J. Whonever any of said property, or any part thereof, shall cease to be used as a park and for pleasure, amusement, recreation, health and uses incident to the aforesaid uses according to

name of said Park from "WILLIAM S. HART PARK" to some other name or designation, or if the County, or its successors in interest or estate, shall fail, neglect or refuse to perform each or any of the other conditions hereby imposed, the said property shall, immediately upon the happening of either or any of said events, revert, and shall go and be distributed, to the State of California for the same uses and purposes and upon the same conditions imposed upon the State of California as are herein set forth and imposed upon the County.

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upon the final account and petition for distribution of my estate, the Board of Supervisors of the County shall advise my exercises of its willingness to accept the property herein devised and bequeathed to the County for the uses and purposes and upon the conditions herein provided. In the event the County fails to so advise my executors prior to the hearing before the Superior Court upon the final account and petition for distribution of my estate, the said real and personal property shall go and be distributed to the State of California for the same uses and purposes and upon the same conditions imposed upon the State of California as are herein set forth and imposed upon the County.

L. All the demestic animals which I may own at the time of my death shall be allowed to spend their remaining days in the Park and shall be properly fed and cared for at all times by the County.

And upkeep of the said Park, I hereby give and bequeath to the County the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00), and such other sums of money as shall go and be distributed to the County under the provisions hereof. IN TRUST, for the following

Trust Estate in a special fund of the County to be known as "WILLIAM S. HART PARK FUND", and shall not withdraw said Trust Estate, nor any portion thereof, except in accordance with the provisions hereof. The County shall place all stocks, bonds and other securities purchased with said Trust Estate in a secure place and a proper record kept of the fact that said securities are a part of this Trust Estate.

- B. The county may invest and reinvest the Trust Estate in investments permissible by law for the investment of trust funds deposited with savings banks as provided by Section 61, Act 652 of the General Laws of the State of California, as amended.
- sum of Ten Mousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) of the principal and accrued Interest of the Trust Estate for the purpose of aiding and assisting and collected income. The County in defraying and carrying out and performing the conditions as expressed in par. Fourth hereof to be done and performed, but I hereby declare it to be a condition of this Trust that the County shall not expend or obligate any portion of the principal or income of this Trust Estate in excess of the said amounts, and that it is a further condition of this Trust that the County shall not expend any portion of the said principal or income of the Trust Estate for any purpose whatseever except as herein expressly authorized.
 - D. At loast annually the Board of Supervisors of the County shall account with respect to all disbursements and obligations incurred in connection with the performance of the conditions set forth in paragraph Fourth hereof.
 - E. The County shall have, respecting bonds, shares of stock and other securities, all the rights, powers and privileges of an owner, including, though without limiting the foregoing, the power of voting, giving proxies, payment of calls, assessments and other sums deemed by the Board of Supervisors expedient for the

protection of the interests of the Trust Estate; participating in voting trusts, pooling agreements; assenting to corporate sales, leases and encumbrances; regardless of limitations, if any, elsewhere in this instrument relative to investments by the County, to have the power of selling or exercising stock subscription or conversion rights, participating in foreclosures, reorganizations, consolidations, mergers and liquidations; and in connection with any such proceedings, to deposit securities with, and transfer title to, my protective or other committee under such terms respecting the deposit thereof as the County may approve.

- F. The County shall keep, accumulate and declare acts of all investments, receipts and disbursements, and other transactions hereunder, and all accounts, books and records relating thereto shall be open to inspection by any interested person at all reasonable times. Within sixty days following the close of each fiscal year, the Board of Supervisors shall file with the County Clork of said County a written report setting forth all investments, receipts and disbursements, and other transactions effected by them during the period subsequent to the last accounting. Such report shall contain an exact description of all securities and investments held at the end of such period and the cost of each item thereof as carried on the books of the County.
- G. No portion of the principal or income of the Trust Estate shall be subject to sale, assignment, hypothecation or transfer by the county, nor shall the principal of the Trust Estate, or the income arising therefrom, be liable for any debt of the County or subject to any judgment rendered against the County or to the process of any court in aid of execution of any judgment so rendered, and all of the income from the Trust Estate shall be transferable, payable and deliverable only by the County to the persons

All dividends accruing on corporate account and payane in the shares of the corporation itself, and all rights to subscribe to the shares or other securities or obligations of a corporation accruing on account of the ownership of stock in such corporation, and the proceeds of any sale of such rights, shall be deemed principal. All dividends payable otherwise than in the shares of the corporation itself shall be deemed income, except that amount paid on corporate stock upon liquidation of the assets of the corporation as a return of the original investment and such part of. dividends as is designated by the corporation as a return of cupital or distribution of assets shall be deemed principal. Where the County shall have the option of receiving a dividend either in cash or in the shares of the declaring corporation, it shall be considered a cash dividend irrespective of the choice made by the County. Unless otherwise specifically provided herein, the County shall have absolute discretion in determining what is principal or income and what shall be charged or credited to either, and their judgment shall bind everyone beneficially interested herounder. The County may rely upon the statement of the paying corporation as to whother dividends are pald from profits or earnings or are a return of capital or a distribution of assets, and as to any other fact relevant hereunder, concerning the source or character
